Adriana and Josh were married beneath a textured huppah of branches and curly willows softened with cascading hydrangeas, roses and amaranthus.



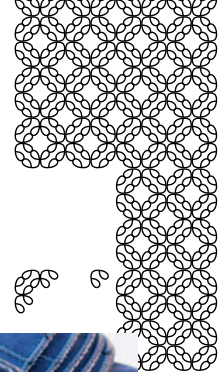

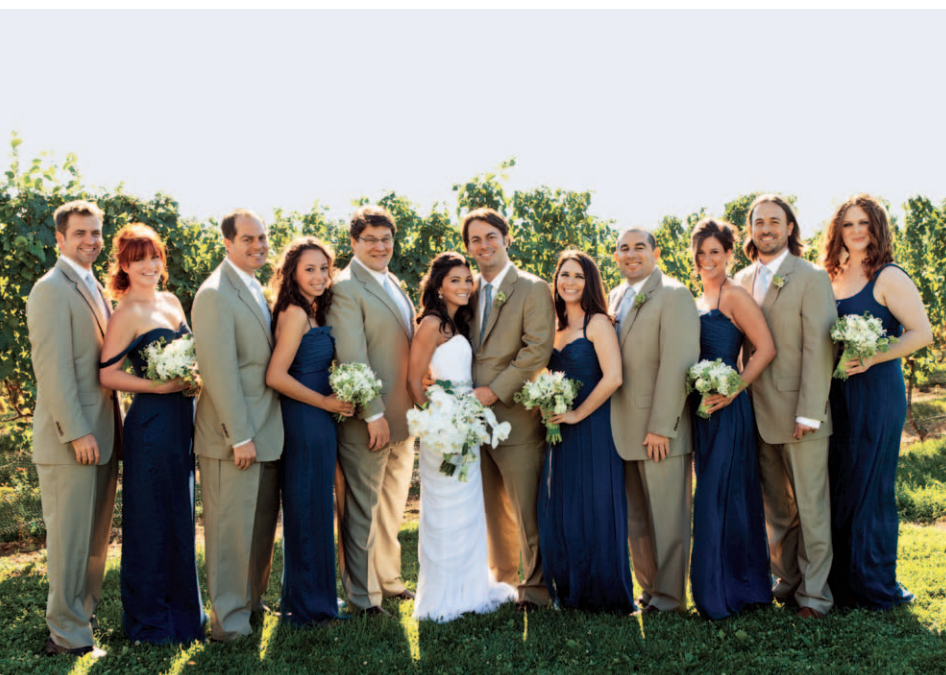
